Kuvasz Club of America Annual Awards Policy

(Revisions approved January 22, 2005)

I. Annual Awards Committee

A. All members of the Annual Awards Committee (AAC) will be members in good standing of the Kuvasz Club of America.

B. The AAC will consist of an odd number of members, no fewer than three, inclusive of the Chairperson.

1. The KCA Board of Directors will appoint the AAC Chairperson.
2. The AAC Chairperson will choose all other committee members.

II. Responsibilities of the Committee:

A. The AAC will coordinate all Annual Awards with the KCA Board of Directors and the National Specialty Chairperson.

B. Award Determination

1. The AAC will directly acquire records of AKC titles awarded.
2. The AAC will confirm all other awards. Owners need to apply for awards that are not directly reported by AKC, and applications must be received by the AAC Chairperson no later than one month prior to the date of the National Specialty at which the award is to be presented. AAC members will support owners to the best of their ability to identify potential award winners.

a) A reminder to the membership will be published yearly in the Winter Kuvasz Quarterly that owners must apply for the awards. Owners may review the Annual Awards policy in the Kuvasz Quarterly or may go to the KCA website for eligibility criteria and application forms, which can be printed out from the website. Those who cannot access the website may contact the Annual Awards Committee for a copy of the eligibility requirements for annual awards and application forms.

C. A committee member will be designated as the New Titles Coordinator by a majority vote of the committee. This person will:

1. Receive monthly reports directly from AKC containing the new titles earned by Kuvasz
2. Receive documentation directly from owners of all certifications, except Canine Good Citizens, as those are received and reported by the Obedience Committee
3. Receive documentation directly from owners of all non AKC titles earned by Kuvasz
4. Report titles and certifications other than CGC's in the Kuvasz Quarterly and on the website
5. Record these titles and certifications in the AAC's records
6. Obtain CGC reports generated by the Obedience Committee and include

them in AAC's records

D. Records

1. The AAC will keep detailed records on awards earned and awarded.
2. AAC records will be available upon request.
3. The AAC chairperson will forward records to a new chairperson within 30 days of the new chairperson's appointment.
4. The AAC will provide award information to all of the club's informational services (e.g., the Kuvasz Quarterly, the KCA website).

E. Policy

1. The AAC will write all policy regarding Annual Awards.
2. All policy is subject to approval by the Board of Directors.

III. Awards Year

- A. The awards year will be from January 1st to December 31st.
- B. Awards will be presented at the banquet held in conjunction with the National Specialty following the Awards year.
- C. Awards will be mailed if the owner is unable to attend the National Specialty.

IV. Awards Eligibility

A. An owner must:

1. Be a member in good standing of the KCA during the year in which the eligibility requirements for the award were completed or had applied for membership in the last quarter of the year in which the eligibility requirements were completed.
2. Be the owner of record at the time the eligibility requirements are completed.
 - a) The AAC will use AKC published information to determine ownership.
 - b) In case a change of ownership is not reflected in AKC publications, it is the owner's responsibility to notify AAC and provide documentation of the change.

B. An individual dog may qualify for awards from more than one (1) category.

C. No more than one (1) award at each level of a category will be awarded to an individual dog.

D. Point totals are cumulative over any number of years and a dog need not be living to qualify.

V. Kuvasz Club of America Annual Awards

A. The following Annual Awards will be presented at the National Specialty Banquet in the following order:

1. Kuvasz Kompanions (KK)
2. Annual Titles (AKC titles only)
3. Conformation Performance Awards (CPA)
4. Obedience Performance Award (OPA)
5. Tracking Performance Award (TPA)
6. Standard Agility Performance Award (SAPA)
7. Jumpers Agility Performance Award (JAPA)
8. Therapy Performance Award (ThPA)
9. Versatility Performance Award (VPA)
10. Outstanding Sire Award (OS)
11. Outstanding Dam Award (OD)
12. Conformation Outstanding Achievement Award (COAA)
13. Obedience Outstanding Achievement Award (OOAA)
14. Tracking Outstanding Achievement Award (TOAA)
15. Standard Agility Outstanding Achievement Award (SAOAA)
16. Jumpers Agility Outstanding Achievement Award (JAOAA)
17. Therapy Outstanding Achievement Award (ThOAA)
18. Versatility Outstanding Achievement Award (VOAA)
19. Top Kuvasz of the Year in Versatility.
20. Top Kuvasz of the Year Breed Points
21. Best of Opposite Sex Breed Points
22. Top Kuvasz of the Year All-Breed Points
23. Best of Opposite Sex All-Breed Points
24. KCA Service Award
25. Special Awards

B. The AAC will present Awards 1 – 24. The National Specialty Committee will present Award 25.

C. Awards will be in the following form

1. Medallions for Titles
2. Certificates for KK, CPA, OPA, TPA, SAPA, JAPA, ThPA, VPA, OS, and OD
3. Plaques for COAA, OOAA, TOAA, SAOAA, JAOAA, ThOAA, VOAA, Top Kuvasz in Versatility, Top Kuvasz Breed Points, BOS Breed Points, Top Kuvasz All-Breed Points, BOS All-Breed Points, and Service Award.

D. Duplicate awards for co-owners

1. No duplicates will be issued for new AKC titles. One medallion will be presented to the primary owner of the dog as determined by the first name in published ownership data.
2. Duplicates, in the form of a paper document, will be issued for the certificate and plaque awards for co-owners residing in separate households from the primary owner. Only co-owners who meet the criteria for awards eligibility as specified in Section IV-A will be issued a duplicate award, and only one award or duplicate award per household will be issued.

VI. Special Awards

A. Special Awards may be offered by individual KCA members. These awards are intended for specific accomplishments, achieved at the KCA National Specialty Shows/Trials, that a donor wishes to honor, and can be earned by and awarded to non-KCA members (unless the donor specifies otherwise).

B. Requests to offer Special Awards must be made by detailed written proposal to the AAC Chairperson, and must conform to AKC rules/regulations and KCA Annual Awards policy. The AAC will review proposals and work with donors to ensure compliance, prior to the AAC's submitting proposals, with a recommendation, to the KCA Board for final approval/implementation.

C. Proposals for Special Awards should include as a minimum, the following information:

Name of the award

Description of the award

Stated dollar value of the award

Donors' names

Purpose of the award

Criteria for earning the award

Type of award (perpetual, challenge)

If a memento/token of the award will be given to every winner to keep permanently

D. Those Special Awards that meet the criteria established by AKC for presentation in the ring, may be awarded at the National Specialty Show/Obedience Trial. Currently the only Special Award that meets these criteria is the Hank Fellerman Memorial Challenge Trophy for HIT. Those Special Awards that do not meet the criteria for presentation in the ring may be displayed outside the ring and may appear in show photographs taken outside the ring, but will be presented by the National Specialty Show Chairperson (or his/her designee), at the Specialty Banquet, following the Annual Awards presentation by the AAC.

E. Policy provided by the National Specialty Coordinator: The National Perpetual Trophies are presented at the National Specialty; therefore, it is imperative to have these trophies available for presentation at each National Specialty show. It is the responsibility of the individual(s) receiving said trophies to have these delivered to the National Specialty Chair (or his/her designee) in time to be at the site of the next National Specialty no later than the morning of the Specialty. It is furthermore the responsibility of this individual to have the name plates engraved with the proper information regarding dog, owner, breeder, etc., prior to returning them. All costs associated with engraving and shipping will be the responsibility of the individuals who received them. All recipients must sign a contract to agree to the criteria at the time of presentation and before departing the banquet or designated award presentation location. For shipment, UPS or other methods, there will be a minimum insurance coverage to be included based on the estimated and stated original value of each trophy (designated in a separate document under trophy description). Insurance coverage to be the responsibility of the shipper. It is the responsibility of the National Specialty Chair (or his/her designee) to contact the holders of the Perpetual Trophies from the previous year at least one month before the Specialty date with the address of where the trophies should be shipped.

VII. Award Requirements

A. All AKC recognized titles earned during the awards year will be acknowledged.

1. Awards for new titles will be determined by the AAC. (No owner submitted applications required).

B. KK, CPA, OPA, TPA, SAPA, JAPA, ThPA, VPA, OS, OD, COAA, OOAA, TOAA, SAOAA, JAOAA, ThOAA, VOAA, and Top Kuvasz of the Year in Versatility shall be awarded according to the criteria in Appendix A.

1. Owners need to apply for these awards. Appendices B, C, D, and E contain the Application Forms.

C. Top Kuvasz and BOS Breed Points, Top Kuvasz and BOS All-Breed Points

1. Canine Chronicle end-of-year ratings will be used.

2. Will be researched by the AAC with no application needed from owners.

D. Special Awards

1. All Special Awards will be given in accordance with the criteria set forth by the donor. See list in Appendix F.

E. Service Award

1. The KCA Service Award is offered yearly to recognize outstanding individuals, human and/or canine, for their humanitarian efforts. It will be given to honor those who have acted selflessly for the betterment of all.
2. Selection will be as follows:
 - a) Recipients must be a member of the KCA for the year in which he/she is nominated and at the time of the award presentation.
 - b) Any club member may nominate any other member. A notice requesting nominations will be submitted by the KCA Awards Committee to the Kuvasz Quarterly for each Winter issue.
 - c) All nominations for this award will be sent to the KCA Awards Committee by a date at least 1 month prior to that year's National Specialty.
 - d) The KCA Awards Committee will send copies of all nominations to the KCA President, the National Specialty Show Chairperson, and the last recipient of the Service Award.
 - e) The KCA president, National Specialty Show Chairperson and the last recipient will vote on the nominees and send a written notice of their choice of recipient to the KCA Awards Committee.

VIII. KCA Awards Designations

A. Kuvasz earning the awards of KK, CPA, OPA, TPA, SAPA, JAPA, ThPA, VPA, OS, OD, COAA, OOAA, TOAA, SAOAA, JAOAA, ThOAA, and VOAA will be entitled to use these initials at the end of the dog's name in advertising and on pedigrees.

B. These titles are not AKC recognized and do not become part of the dog's registered name.

APPENDIX A

Award Criteria

Kuvasz Kompanions

All of the criteria below must be met to be awarded a Kuvasz Kompanion certificate.

1. A veterinarian's certification that the dog has been spayed or neutered (e.g., vaccination records that contains this information).
2. An AKC Canine Good Citizen certificate.
3. Proof of permanent identification.

Conformation

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together. A total of 20 points is necessary to be awarded the Conformation Performance Award. A total of 100 points is necessary to be awarded the Conformation Outstanding Achievement Award. Achievements from AKC shows only will be accepted. Group placements in the regular classes only will be accepted.

Obedience

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together. A total of 15 points is necessary to be awarded the Obedience Performance Award. A total of 20 points is necessary to be awarded the Obedience Outstanding Achievement Award. Achievements from AKC trials only will be accepted.

Tracking

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together. A total of 15 points is necessary to be awarded the Tracking Performance Award. A total of 20 points is necessary to be awarded the Tracking Outstanding Achievement Award. Achievements from AKC tests only will be accepted.

Standard Agility

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together, however only regular or preferred points may be used at a given titling level (e.g., a dog with an NA and a NAP would earn 5 points toward a SAPA or a SAOAA not 8). A total of 15 points is necessary to be awarded the Standard Agility Performance Award. A total of 30 points is necessary to be awarded the Standard Agility Outstanding Achievement Award. Achievements from AKC trials only will be accepted.

Jumpers Agility

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together, however only regular or preferred points may be used at a given titling level (e.g., a dog with an NAJ and a NJP would earn 5 points toward a JAPA or a JAOAA not 8). A total of 15 points is necessary to be awarded the Jumpers Agility Performance Award. A total of 30 points is necessary to be awarded the Jumpers Agility Outstanding Achievement Award. Achievements from AKC trials only will be accepted.

Versatility

Points for each achievement in the schedule below are added together. A total of 4 points from at least 2 different categories is necessary to be awarded a Versatility Performance Award, with a minimum of 2 points needed per category used to count toward the VPA award.

A total of 7 or more points from at least 3 different categories is necessary to be awarded a Versatility Outstanding Achievement Award, with a minimum of 2 points needed per category used to count toward the VOAA award.

The Top Kuvasz of the Year in Versatility will be determined using the Versatility Point Schedule below; however:

- Accumulated points will be limited to the awards year in which the achievement was accomplished (January 1st-December 31st), and will not carry over from one awards year to the next,
- Points must be earned in at least two categories within that same year, and a minimum of 2 points is needed per category to count toward the award,
- No type of achievement may be used more than once in any given year, to count toward the award.

Only achievements from AKC shows/trials/tests, group placements in the regular classes and the specific certifications listed below will be accepted.

Outstanding Sire Award Requirements

Sires must have at least 6 individual qualifying get. The qualifying get must have earned a total of at least 20 points among them. Points will be awarded per the schedule.

Outstanding Dam Award Requirements

Dams must have at least 4 individual qualifying get. The qualifying get must have earned a total of at least 15 points among them. Points will be awarded per the schedule.

Only AKC titles will be accepted.

Therapy

Therapy dog awards are based on the number of hours spent working in an institution. A total of 20 hours of therapy work is necessary to be awarded the Therapy Performance Award. A total of 100 hours of therapy work is necessary to be awarded the Therapy Outstanding Achievement Award. An application containing institution visited, date, number of hours, and signature of a responsible person at the institution must be completed (see Appendix D).

- Possession to breeder until next national Specialty. ***signed contract required***

The BIS/BISS CH Szumeria's Nala of Silverpick Trophy

- Tiffany sterling silver Revere bowl, approximately 12" in diameter, donated by Lynn Brady, Connie Townsend, and David & Claudia Hoffman.
- This is a challenge trophy, to be presented to the person who is the owner/breeder/handler of the Best in Specialty Show at the National Specialty.
- First offered at the National Specialty in 2000.
- If no person qualifies to receive the award in any year, the trophy is not to be awarded that year.
- Each winner will be responsible for engraving on the trophy, his/her win information for that year: the name of the winner, the name of the BOB Kuvasz, and the date & location of the national Specialty at which it was won.
- Possession to owner/breeder/handler until the next National Specialty.
- Upon a person's receiving the award 3 times, whether or not with the same Best of Breed winner, such person shall be given permanent possession of the trophy and it shall thereby be retired.

The Hank Fellerman Memorial Challenge Trophy

- Engraved 12 x 15" walnut and bronze plaque donated by the Friends of Hank Fellerman
- Given to HIT winner with contract. HIT winner has plate engraved on plaque to include owner's name, dog's name, specialty date, and specialty location.
- Permanent possession to be awarded to the owner of the dog winning High in Trial at the national Specialty 3 times, not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows.
- Memento 7 x 9 inch plaque to be presented to the owner of each national Specialty High in Trial winner.
